Open Letter

Dear Olaf Scholz,

thank you for keeping a cool mind in this extreme situation and for "scholzing" relating to the cruise missile attacks on Russia, as ZDF explains to children in an outrageous way.

Obviously, the situation is becoming increasingly tense and hopeless. We are not so much referring to the situation in Ukraine itself, but to you and your environment, to people who are not prepared to let the earth go under in order to escape the guillotine, figuratively speaking, in their bunkers during the chaos instigated on the earth's surface.

Yet salvation is so near and within reach.

As your desperate old environment loses strength and power, the other side is reaching out to you. And you know that Russia under Putin is the most respectful of the current world powers - respectful of their friendly countries and supporting their sovereignty. With regard to your personal situation, there would be good mediators within your reach.

How about a "party" on a boat, together with people like Ralph T. Niemeyer and Sarah Wagenknecht and possibly even your old comrade Gerhard Schröder?

These capable people should be able to mediate with you and create a way out - for you personally and for Germany. Forgetting the past will be difficult, especially with the first two - an amnesty, on the other hand, would be an appropriate action for such a heroic act, which the entire German people should support as soon as the dust has settled and the truth of recent years comes to light.

We are also happy to provide you with advice and support along the way - even if you may not know us. But we also have a lot to offer...
